Величає душа моя Господа, і дух мій радіє в Бозі, Спасі моїм.

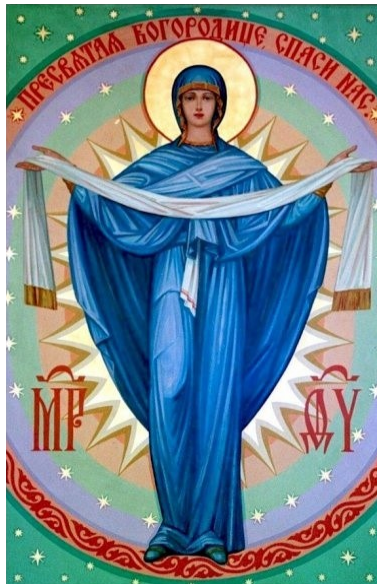
Посвята себе Матері Божій

Troparion:

Protected by your coming, O Mother of God, the faithful people solemnly celebrate today; and gazing upon your immaculate image, they humbly say: Watch over us with your noble protection, and deliver us from all evil by asking your Son, Christ our God, to save our souls.

Today the Virgin is present in the Church and with the armies of Saints invisibly prays to God for us. The angels worship with the archangels and the apostles rejoice with the prophets; because, in our behalf, the Mother of God prays to the eternal God.

Prokimen;

My soul extols the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my savior.

METANOIA – and believe in the Gospel

In the Gospel of Mark, the first words of Jesus are an invitation to metanoia, to repent, to change, to be converted. Every Catholic, no matter where we are in our faith journey, is invited to a deeper conversion. Metanoia is not a one-time event; rather, it is a continual process of turning away from the things of the world, from lies and sin and discovering a deeper union with Christ.

Metanoia is a 10 part series that is beautifully filmed on location in the Holy Land, highlighting sacred places and many of the holy sites in Jerusalem. This series will lead us on a journey with Christ into conversion. Each of the episodes explores areas of our life where conversion is so often necessary.

Metanoia will examine topics such as who is Jesus, what must we do to inherit eternal life, and many other significant matters of faith. With preaching from Fr. Dave Pivonka, TOR - President of Franciscan University and founder of The Ministry of the Wild Goose, as well as personal testimonies from men and women, young and old, religious and lay, their stories will inspire you to seek to encounter Jesus and the new life he is constantly inviting us to.

Join us for the most important journey of our lives, a journey of grace, hope, repentance, and transformation. Do not delay, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel. Mk 1:15"
