Почитання Пресвятої Богородиці

У соборі святих першість належить Пресвятій Богородиці. Вона ϵ іконою Церкви, символом і первістком переображеного благодаттю людства, взірцем і твердою надією для всіх, хто прямує до небесного Єрусалиму. Разом із нею предстоять перед небесним Престолом апостоли, євангелисти, мученики, ісповідники, посники й усяка праведна душа, що спочила у вірі. Усі вони ϵ живими іконами Божими, свідками та носіями нового творіння. Вони предстоять перед Богом у своїх безнастанних молитвах і присутні серед нас Божою благодаттю у своїх мощах та іконах.

Церква соборно сповідує Марію, Матір Господа нашого Ісуса Христа, Богородицею і Приснодівою і почитає її у святах літургійного року та в іконах. Церква в Богородичних святах молитовно споминає спасенні події життя Богородиці: Зачаття святою Анною, Різдво, Введення у храм, Благовіщення, Стрітення та Успення, вбачаючи в ній взірець для нашого зростання у святості.

Ікона Знамення зображає Христа в лоні Діви — знак, провіщений пророком Ісаєю. Ікона Одигітрія зображає Богородицю, яка вказує на Христа —путь, істину і життя. Ікона Умилення (Зворушення) зображає тісне сопричастя Матері і Сина. Ікона Матері Божої неустанної помочі описує споглядання Божим Дитям майбутніх Страстей та наголошує на співстражданні Богородиці в страстях її Сина. Ікона Оранта (з латинської та, що молиться) зображає Пресвяту Богородицю з піднятими у молитві руками, як заступницю за людський рід перед Отцем Небесним.

До Богородиці, першої обожествленої, Церква зі сміливістю звертається словами: Пресвята Богородице, спаси нас, розуміючи, що спасає благодать Божа, яка діє в ній. Її спокійна й легка, наче сон, смерть у повноті благодаті стала пробудженням до неба і була названа Успенням. Успення Богородиці показане на іконі празника як народження для неба: Христос тримає на руках сповиту пеленами душу Марії. У святкуванні Успення Церква ісповідує, що Богородиця у смерті не зазнала тілесного тління, а переставилася, від землі до небесних обителей переселившись — тілом і душею була піднесена Господом до небесної слави. Першою з-поміж людського роду Богородиця була прославлена у своєму (прод. на стор. 3)

Devotion to the Most Holy Mother of God

In the assembly of all the saints, the first place belongs to the most holy Mother of God. She is the "icon of the Church, the symbol and anticipation of humanity transfigured by grace, the model and the unfailing hope for all those who direct their steps towards the heavenly Jerusalem." Standing together with her before the heavenly throne are "the apostles, preachers, evangelists, martyrs, confessors, ascetics, and every righteous soul that finished this life in faith." They are all living icons of God, witnesses and bearers of the new creation. They stand before God in unceasing prayer; and they are present among us by the grace of God in their relics and icons.

In unified conciliar fashion, the Church professes Mary, the Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ, to be the God-bearing One (Ukrainian: Bohorodytsia) or Mother of God and Ever-Virgin; and the Church venerates her in the feasts of the liturgical year and in icons. At Marian feasts, the Church prayerfully commemorates the saving events of the life of the Mother of God: the Conception by Saint Anne, the Mother of God's Nativity, her Entrance into the Temple, the Annunciation, the Encounter in the Temple, and her Dormition. The Church sees in her the perfect model for our growth in holiness.

The Icon of the Sign portrays Christ in the womb of the Virgin, a sign, foretold by the prophet Isaiah. The icon Hodegetria portrays the Mother of God who points to Christ, "the way, the truth, and the life." . The icon of Tenderness portrays the intimate communion of Mother and Son. The icon of the Mother of God of Perpetual Help presents the Divine Child contemplating his future Passion and emphasizes the co-suffering of the Mother of God in the Passion of her Son. The icon called *Oranta* (from the Latin, meaning *she who prays*) portrays the most holy Mother of God with arms uplifted in prayer, interceding for the human race before the heavenly Father.

With boldness, the Church addresses the Mother of God, the first to be divinized by grace, with the words, "Most holy Mother of God, save us." The Church does so with the understanding that it is God's grace that saves and acts in her. Her peaceful death, tranquil as sleep in the fullness of grace, became an awakening into heaven itself; it is appropriately called the Dormition (Falling-Asleep). The Dormition of the Mother of God is portrayed on the icon of the feast as a birth into heaven: Christ holds in his arms the soul (Cont. on pg. 3)

of Mary, wrapped in swaddling clothes. In the celebration of the Dormition, the Church professes that in her death the Mother of God did not undergo bodily corruption, but has been "translated from earth to heaven," "raised body and soul into heavenly glory by the Lord." From among the human race, the Mother of God was the first to be glorified in her body. This is an image of our own resurrection as well. The Mother of God, being the Mother of Life, was transferred to Life; and "in her Dormition she did not abandon the world." Her constant intercession before the Creator is celebrated by the Church in the feast of the Protection of the Most Holy Mother of God: "Today the Virgin stands before us in the church, and together with the choirs of saints invisibly prays to God for us."
