1. Offer up your intentions.
2. Bless yourself by making the sign of the Cross (3 times).
3. "Glory to You, our God, Glory to You".
4. "Heavenly King, Advocate, Spirit of the Truth..."
5. "Nicene Creed", on the first large bead.
6. "Glory to the Father, Who created us, now, always, and forever. Amen. Hail Mary...", on first small bead.
7. "And Glory to the Son, Who has redeemed us, always, and forever. Amen. Hail Mary...", on the second small bead.
8. "And Glory to the Holy Spirit, Who enlightens us, now, always, and forever. Amen. Hail Mary...", on the third small bead.
9. The Doxology: "Glory be..." and announce the first mystery (pause and reflect on the mystery).
10. "Our Father...", on the next large bead.
11. Ten "Hail Mary..." on the small beads.
12. The Doxology: "Glory be..." and "O my Jesus..."
13. Announce the next mystery, then "Our Father..." and so on ...(11), (12).
14. After the 5th decade: "Hail Holy Queen..."

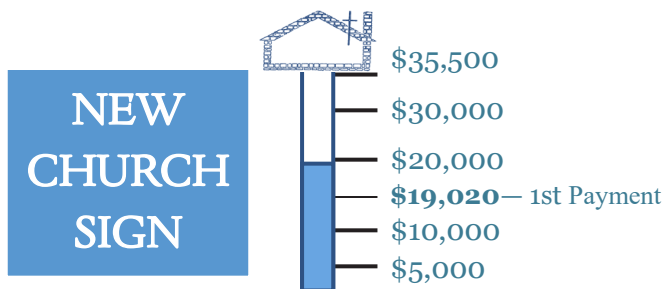

JOIN US every Tuesday 7:30 pm - 9:00 pm starting October 5th, 2021 for a weekly video-based study where Bishop Robert Barron leads us line-by-line through the elegant, intelligent, and succinct words of the Creed. These words, such as believe, one God, incarnate, and consubstantial, will resonate in your soul and more deeply give voice to your own faith once you experience Bishop Barron's The Creed.

"The Creed" is a new film series from Bishop Barron, that blends documentary conversations and dynamic talks. The OLPH sodality will be hosting a Rosary Rally at our church. This rosary, for the Lady of Fatima, will be said around the world at the same time.

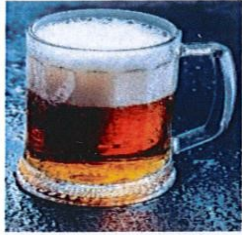

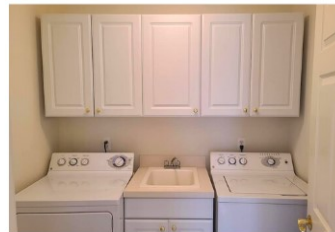
