Молитва Церкви

(Христос Наша Пасха – ст. 121 #352-54)

Літургія Слова (літургія оглашенних)

Христос виходить на проповідь після хрещення в Йордані від Йоана, закликаючи: «Сповнився час, і царство Боже близько; покайтеся і вірте в Євангеліє.» Він проповідує царство протягом трьох років і звершує його в Пасхальному таїнстві. На тайній Вечері Христос дарував апостолам участь у царстві — своєму божественному житті — через Слово та Євхаристію.

Таке поєднання Слова і таїнства не випадкове. Як Богородиця спочатку прийняла до серця Слово і з'єдналася з ним, так і ми приймаємо до серця Слово і виконуємо Його, коли єднаємося з ним у таїнстві Причастя: «Мати моя й брати мої – це ті, що слухають Слово Боже і його виконують.» Тому в Божественній Літургії Христос спочатку живить нас своїм Словом (апостола, Євангелія і проповіді), а тоді тілом і кров'ю (Причастя).

Літургію Слова приймаємо не як спогад про Христове проповідування, а як живе Слово, яке Христос і надалі звіщає і яке ми не лише читаємо, а й приймаємо як поживу. Він через проголошене й проповідуване слово під час літургійного зібрання Сам звертається до всієї церковної спільноти й до кожного зосібна.

Виголос «Благословенне Царство» і Мирна єктенія

Як прилюдна діяльність Христова почалась проголошенням пришестя царства Божого, так і Літургія починається звіщенням присутності царства. Священик, навхрест знаменуючи Євангелієм святий престол, виголошує: «Благословенне царство отця, і Сина, і Святого духа, нині і повсякчас, і на віки вічні», на що учасники Літургії відповідають: «амінь» (з єврейської — Нехай так буде), сповідуючи, що царство дійсно є серед нас, і прагнучи, щоб воно зростало.

У Мирній єктенії ми приносимо Господеві молитву церкви за весь світ. Цим церковна спільнота сповідує явлене царство Боже. Молитва церкви за світ — вияв віри, що все є в Божих руках, і вияв готовності прийняти від Господа відповідь, яку Він зволить дати. У назві єктенії «Мирна» наголошується на потребі внутрішнього миру та примирення з усіма. Перше прохання єктенії вказує на те, що нашим миром є Сам Христос і в ньому молимося. Прохання Мирної єктенії охоплюють благо церкви, країни й усього творіння. Мирна єктенія виховує вірних ставити спільні справи понад приватні. Молитва «Господи, помилуй», яку вірні повторюють як відповідь спільноти на прохання єктенії, містить у собі і прохання про Божу милість, а також віру спільноти в те, що Він завжди дарує її.

The Liturgy of the Word (Liturgy of the Catechumens)

After his baptism by John in the Jordan, Jesus began his preaching, crying out: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news." He preaches the kingdom for three years and brings it to fruition in the Paschal Mystery. At the Mystical Supper, Christ gave the apostles a share in the kingdom—his divine life—through the Word and the Eucharist. This joining of the Word and the Mystery is not a coincidence. As the Mother of God first received the Word into her heart and united herself to him, so also we receive the Word into our hearts and put it into practice when we join ourselves to him in the mystery of Communion: "My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it." This is why in the Divine Liturgy Christ feeds us first with his Word (in the Epistle, the Gospel, and the homily), and then with his Body and Blood (Communion).

We approach the Liturgy of the Word not as a simple recollection of Christ's preaching long ago, but rather as the living Word. Christ continues to preach today, and we not only read this Word but also receive it as nourishment. Through the proclaimed and preached Word in the liturgical assembly, Christ himself addresses the whole Church community and every member individually.

Exclamation "Blessed be the Kingdom" and the Litany of Peace As the public activity of Christ began with the proclamation that God's kingdom was at hand, so the Liturgy begins with the announcement that the kingdom is present. Signing the Holy Table with the Gospel Book cross-wise, the priest exclaims: "Blessed be the kingdom of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever." To this the participants at the Liturgy respond: "Amen" (from the Hebrew, meaning let it be so). By this response they assert that the kingdom is truly among us and that they long for it to thrive and grow.

In the Litany of Peace we bring before the Lord the Church's prayer for the whole world. This is the way the liturgical assembly affirms the manifestation of God's kingdom. The Church's prayer for the world is an expression of faith that all is in the hands of the Lord. It also expresses our readiness to accept from the Lord whatever answer he might wish to give. The name of the Litany of Peace indicates the need for inner peace and reconciliation with all. The first petition of the Litany indicates that Christ himself is our peace and that it is in him that we pray. The petitions of the Litany of Peace express concern for the good of the Church, of the country in which we live, and of all creation. The Litany of Peace teaches the faithful to place common needs before private ones. The prayer "Lord, have mercy," repeated by the faithful as the community's response to the petitions, includes both the request for God's merciful love and the community's faith that he unfailingly proffers that love.






