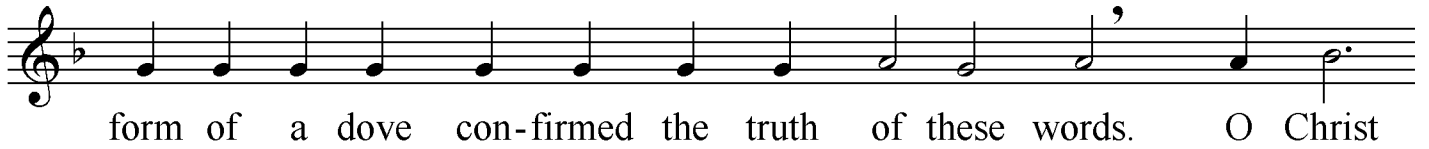
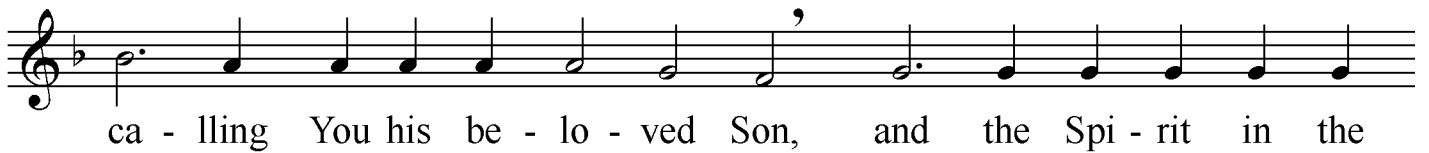
Antiphones 1 and 3: verses and refrains can be recited the same way as it is noted in the Theophany music notes.

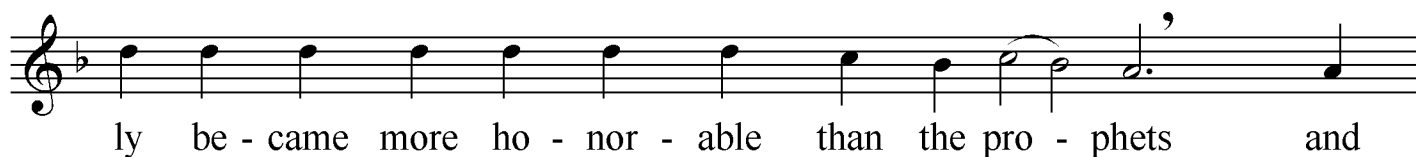
Antiphone 3 is as on Sunday, however with this refrain:

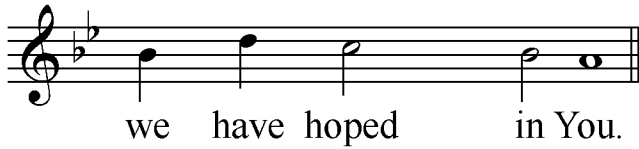
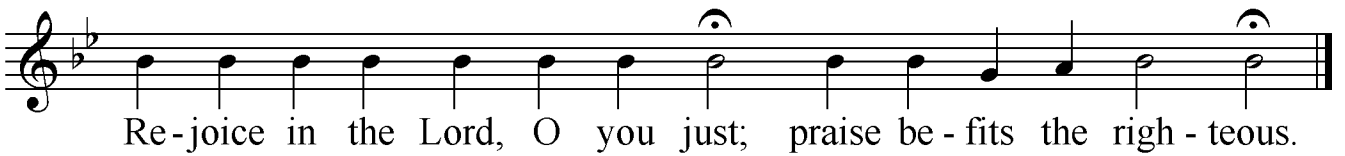

Instead of "It is truly right" the Hirmos of Theophany is sung

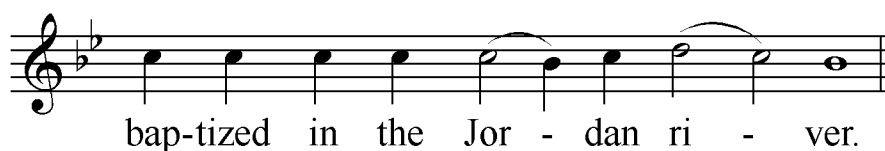
