the Kontakion (Tone 4) follows**

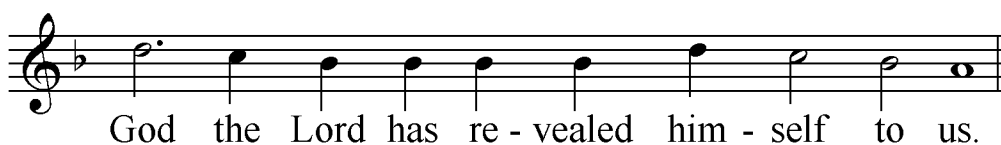




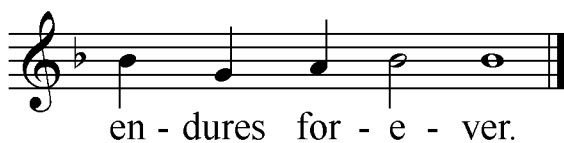
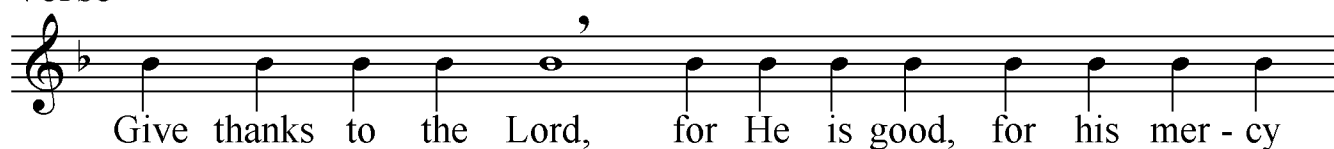
