(Христос Наша Пасха – ст. 133-4 #399-400)

Чини літургії святого Йоана золотоустого та святого Василія Великого

Далі анафора Літургії святого Василія Великого згадує про те, як людина, зваблена змієм, скоїла гріх непослуху, і через це втратила рай та стала смертною. Благий Бог, однак, не відвернувся від людини, а провістив прийдешнє спасіння, дав на закон, посилав пророків, захистив ангелами-хоронителями. остаточно Бог промовив через Свого Сина. Той умалив Себе, воплотившись від діви. Він Своєю плоттю засудив гріх і дарував нове життя. Себе ж віддав замість нас на смерть, а воскресінням простелив шлях у вічне життя кожній людині. Першим з-поміж людей Він воскрес, вознісся і сів праворуч отця. Нам же залишив на спомин Своїх страстей оце возношення дарів. Бо тоді Він першим узяв хліб і вино, назвав їх Своїм тілом і кров'ю, дав їсти і пити учням і заповів робити це й надалі. Нині цей заповіт виконує літургійна спільнота, а дух Святий освячує дари та являє їх тілом і кров'ю Ісуса Христа.

Святий Дух об'єднує померлих і живих у єдину церкву. Церковною молитвою просимо Господа пом'янути доброчинців, подвижників, народ, правління і воїнство, подружжя і сім'ї, людей нужденних, відпалих від церкви, біснуватих, подорожніх, вдів і сиріт, полонених і недужих, засуджених і утиснених, друзів і ворогів. Анафора Літургії святого Василія Великого завершується радісною певністю, що Господь, даруючи нам усі блага і щедроти, добре поліття, дощі та врожай і вгамовуючи церковний розбрат, гордовитість народів, виникнення єресей, являє нас синами світла і синами дня.

The Orders of the Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom

and of Saint Basil the Great (Christ Our Pascha p.137 #399-400) Further, the Anaphora of Saint Basil mentions that humankind, "led astray by the deception of the serpent," committed the sin of disobedience and thus lost paradise, becoming mortal. Yet the merciful God did not turn away from humankind, but promised the coming salvation. He sent them the prophets, and "gave the law as a help ... appointed angels as guardians." In the fullness of time God spoke through his Son, who humbling himself, took on our human nature from the Virgin. In his flesh he condemned sin and granted new life. In our stead he offered himself unto death, "and rising on the third day and making a way for all flesh to the resurrection of the dead," he became "...the first-born of the dead ... ascended into heaven and took his seat at the right hand" of the Father. As a memorial of his passion he left us this offering of the gifts. He was the first who took bread and wine, named them his Body and Blood, and gave them to his disciples as food and drink. And he commanded us from that time onward to do the same. Today the liturgical community keeps this commandment, and the Holy Spirit sanctifies the gifts and shows them to be the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit unites the living and the dead into a single Church. In the Church's prayer, expressed in this Anaphora, we ask the Lord to remember those who have brought offerings, those labouring in spiritual struggles, our earthly nation, the government and the military, couples and families, those in need, those who have strayed from the Church, those troubled by unclean spirits, those travelling, widows and orphans, the imprisoned and the sick, those condemned and those persecuted, friends and foes. The Anaphora of the Liturgy of Saint Basil culminates in joyous certitude. It concludes with the conviction that the Lord, who gives us his kind gifts and mercies—good weather, rain in due season, and the harvest—will restrain the discord of Churches, the pride of nations, the rise of heresies, and will show us to be "children of the light and children of the day."


