





Every verse of Antiphon 3 can be recited this way






The Troparion (Tone 7) "The supernatural bread" is sung after each verse of the Antiphon 3, as needed.

- "Your memorial", then Glory be, now and for ever: Kontakion (Tone 4) "Behold Christ" (see the next pages)




