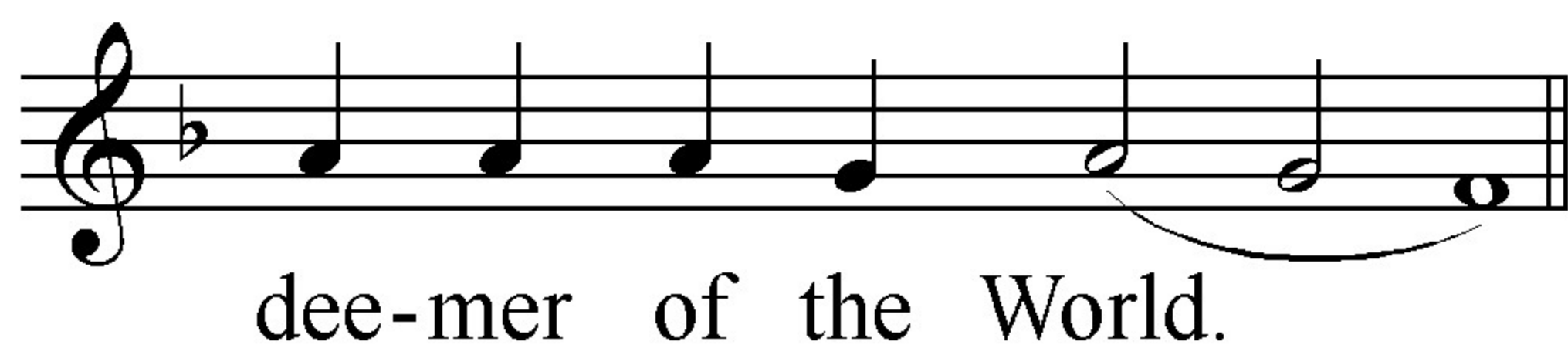
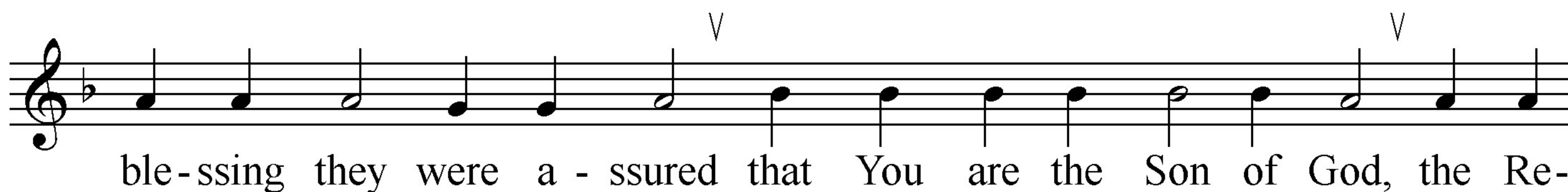
**Antiphon 1 is the same as on the day of the Ascension**
