

Sunday after Theophany

Liturgical Chant

Antiphones 1 and 3: verses and refrains can be recited the same way as it is noted in the Theophany music notes.

Antiphone 3 is as on Sunday, however with this refrain:
Son of God, baptized by John in the Jordan,
save us who sing to You: Alleluia.
