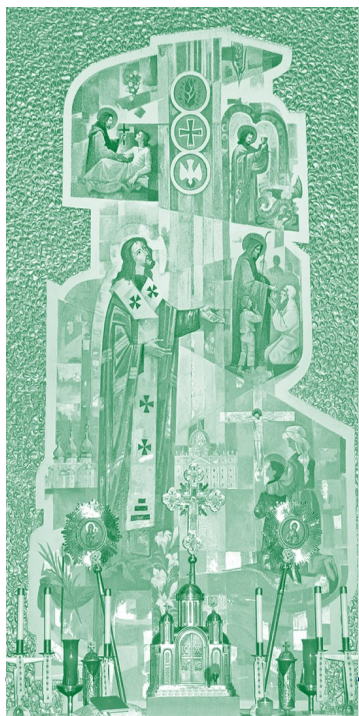

ЩО ТАКЕ АНГЕЛ?

Продовження

Святий Василій Великий вважав, що ангельська природа — це «подих повітря або нематеріальний вогонь». Ось чому вони локалізовані, сказав він, і стають видимими у формі та обрисах власних тіл для тих, хто гідний їх бачити. Ми знаходимо ці уявлення про духовні тіла як у грецьких, так і у латинських отців Церкви. Хоча святий Єронім не має нічого певного щодо природи ангелів, він відкидає аргумент на користь тілесної природи, виведений з книги Буття. Святий Августин вважав більш імовірним, що вони мали тонкі тіла. За його словами, демони до свого гріхопадіння мали такі ж небесні тіла; однак після гріхопадіння їхні тіла складаються з вологого, густого повітря. Св. Касіян чітко висловлює ту саму думку такими словами: «Хоча ми визначаємо духовними деякі субстанції, такі як Ангели, Архангели та інші сили, а також наші власні душі та, безумовно, це тонке повітря, проте їх аж ніяк не слід вважати безтілесними, бо вони по-своєму мають тіло, в якому існують, хоча воно набагато тонше, ніж наше... Звідси випливає, що безтілесний лише Бог».

WHAT IS AN ANGEL?

Continuation

St. Basil the Great believed that the Angelic nature was a “breath of air or an immaterial fire.” This is why they are localized, he said, and become visible, in the form and shape of their own bodies, to those who are worthy to see them. We find these notions about ethereal bodies both among the Greek and the Latin fathers. While Saint Jerome has nothing definite regarding the nature of the Angels, he rejects the argument in favor of a corporeal

nature inferred from Genesis. Saint Augustine thought it more probable that they had subtle bodies. According to him the demons, before their fall, had such heavenly bodies; since their fall, however, their bodies consist of damp, thick air. Cassian clearly expresses the same opinion in these words: “Even though we define as spiritual some of the substances, such as the Angels, the Archangels, and the other powers, as also our own souls and certainly this subtle air, nevertheless they are by no means to be regarded as incorporeal, for in their own way they possess a body whereby they subsist, even though it is a much more subtle one than our own. . . . Hence it appears that God alone is incorporeal.”

FROM URGRENCY TO THE RENEWAL

“ When we first began this campaign, our emotions were deeply mixed. Alongside a sense of hope, there was also uncertainty—persistent questions about whether we would succeed, whether we had the strength to carry it forward, and whether people would respond. We were mindful of the history of our communities in Chicago — a history both blessed and, at times, complex. Many of the parishes that now exist across the city were once rooted in St. Nicholas Cathedral, much like a family whose members grow, mature, and find their own paths.

The launch of this ambitious fundraising effort became a true test. The goal of \$2.6 million seemed daunting, particularly as much of the responsibility rested on a relatively small cathedral community. While we were fortunate to receive professional guidance in shaping a fundraising strategy, the path forward still required faith, perseverance, and trust.

Gradually, through the dedication of our clergy, the support of our Bishop, the commitment of the fundraising committee, and the generosity of the faithful, the campaign began to take on new life. People responded with openness and goodwill, and it became clear that this was not simply an initiative of one parish, but a shared undertaking.

For many of us, the cathedral has long been a cherished spiritual home — a sacred place where we are welcomed into the life of the Church through baptism, united in love through marriage, and prayerfully entrusted to God at life's end. It was especially moving to witness how this sense of belonging extended beyond the cathedral itself. Faithful from other parishes also came forward in support, offering a powerful expression of unity. In doing so, they affirmed that despite past differences—whether cultural, linguistic, or historical — our shared roots remain strong.

What began as a hopeful call to unity and gratitude gradually became a lived reality, made possible through the generosity and faith of so many. We are deeply thankful that the results surpassed all expectations. Even as the scope of the project expanded and costs increased, the faithful continued to respond with unwavering generosity. Their steadfast support and sincere commitment have been a true source of encouragement and grace throughout this journey.

Today, this campaign stands as one of the most significant fundraising efforts among Ukrainian Greek Catholic communities in the United States in recent years. More importantly, it serves as a testament to what can be accomplished when people come together in faith, guided by a shared purpose and sustained by God's blessing. ”

“ The restoration of our cathedral had been long in the making. Over the years, we watched it gradually deteriorate: the roof leaked, structures weakened, and water seeped into the sacristy. We knew action was needed, yet, as often happens, we hesitated—uncertain when the right moment would come, or what sign would guide us. In these moments of doubt, we held in our hearts the words of Jesus to his disciples during a storm: “Why are you afraid, you of little faith?” (Matthew 8:26). Those words reminded us that faith calls us to step forward, even when the path is unclear.

That call became real during a prayer service when part of the ceiling gave way near the faithful. It was a sobering, personal reminder that the time to act had arrived. And so we did. As the work began, it quickly became apparent that this was no ordinary repair. The renovation was vast and intricate. The roof, domes, crosses, structural elements, and stained-glass windows – each required careful attention, expert skill, and significant resources. With every step, new challenges emerged, new needs arose, and the scope of work expanded. What first seemed like a large project soon revealed itself as a true trial, and, at the same time, a profound responsibility. Yet throughout it all, Jesus’ words remained our quiet encouragement, helping us to move forward with trust rather than fear.

There were moments of uncertainty: would we have the strength, the resources, the faith to see it through? And yet, in those moments, we felt support most deeply, from one another and from God’s abiding presence. Faith, we learned, is not the absence of fear, but the courage to act despite it.

Then something remarkable happened. People responded. Donors from the Cathedral and from other parishes offered their support with open hearts. What began as a daunting

task became a shared mission. Today, with immense gratitude, we can say: over \$7.3 million has been raised.

But this is not just about numbers. It is about faith that unites. About memory that brings people back to their spiritual home. About unity that transcends old divides and builds something new.

Today, as the exterior restoration nears completion, much still lies ahead – the interior work, new stages, new challenges. Yet the most important step has already been taken: we have moved forward, guided by faith, hope, and trust, walking this path together.

This journey has taught us a profound truth: we need not wait for extraordinary signs when our hearts already know it is time to act. As Jesus reminds us, even in the midst of uncertainty, courage and faith will carry us through. Step by step, with God’s help, even the most difficult task becomes possible.”

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

ST. NICHOLAS CATHEDRAL RESTORATION

Launched in 2019, the Capital Campaign is a heartfelt Eparchial effort focused on three priorities: restoring St. Nicholas Cathedral, assisting parishes in need, and strengthening the future of our Eparchy. Guided by the dedicated Eparchial Stewardship Committee and Restoration Team, the campaign has grown thoughtfully and purposefully, reaching communities across the Eparchy.

At its core, this effort is made possible by you - our parishioners, partners, and friends. Your generosity and commitment continue to bring this vision to life, and we are deeply grateful for your support.

Restoration Progress

We have already achieved significant milestones in the restoration of St. Nicholas Cathedral, completing essential projects such as structural reinforcements, roof repairs, the restoration of twelve domes and crosses, and the repair of three historic stained-glass windows.

Looking ahead, the remaining scope of work is critical to fully restoring the Cathedral's beauty and integrity. The centerpiece of this effort is the main dome, currently being crafted with exceptional care by our artisan Bohdan Hrynenko. Complementing this work are the stained-glass windows on the main dome and the apse above the sanctuary, which require careful restoration to preserve their historic artistry. Additionally, we will complete the strengthening and cladding of the Cathedral walls to ensure long-lasting structural stability.

These final stages will not only protect and enhance the Cathedral but will also bring to life the full vision of its restoration, ensuring that it stands as a vibrant and enduring symbol of our faith and community.

Fundraising Progress

Because of the inspiring generosity of our donors and supporters, we have now raised \$7.4 million toward the restoration of St. Nicholas Cathedral.

A truly historic moment in this effort came with an extraordinary **\$2 million** gift from an anonymous donor - the largest single donation in the history of our Church. We are deeply grateful for this remarkable act of faith and love, offered by someone whose generosity has become a true "angel" for this mission and has moved us dramatically closer to the finish line.

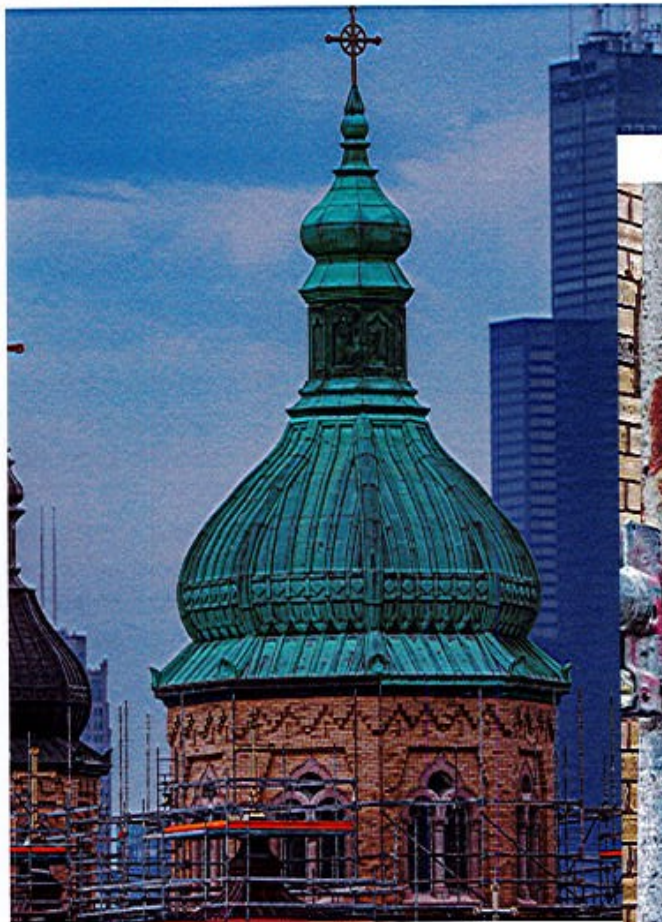
Naming Opportunities Programs

Our Naming Opportunities Programs were met with exceptional enthusiasm across the Eparchy. The domes and crosses initiative, launched in 2020, was fully pledged by the end of 2021, enabling the successful restoration of all twelve domes and crosses, with work on the main dome set to begin this spring and expected to take 18–24 months. The stained-glass window program was equally well received, and thanks to this overwhelming generosity, both programs are now officially closed, with every element spoken for.

At the same time, we are excited to share a new opportunity that was not previously announced. As part of the main dome's restoration, eight windows will undergo full restoration, including replacement of the wooden frames and repair of the stained glass.

We are especially grateful that five of these eight windows have already been generously committed by one of our most devoted supporters and a true friend of St. Nicholas Cathedral. The remaining windows will offer a meaningful opportunity for others who may wish to participate in this unique and lasting part of the cathedral's restoration.

DEVELOPING EPARCHIAL RESOURCES

From its very beginning, the Capital Campaign has focused not only on restoring the Cathedral, but also on strengthening and supporting wider Eparchial development needs. This has included coordinating additional fundraising initiatives, managing both internal and external communications, leading marketing and outreach efforts, and preparing annual grant applications to assist with Eparchial priorities. These responsibilities are carried out by the Eparchial Stewardship & Development Office, which is fully supported through the Capital Campaign.

Communication across the Eparchy remains an important part of the Stewardship & Development Office's work, helping to ensure strong coordination and alignment among the many initiatives taking place throughout the Eparchy. This includes maintaining open and ongoing dialogue between the Eparchial Curia, parishes, and clergy. These efforts are further supported through quarterly newsletters, the Annual Capital Campaign Report, and regular personal engagement with key stakeholders.

Other Eparchial Fundraising Campaigns

Besides the *Capital Campaign*, there are other ongoing fundraising initiatives in our eparchy. *The Annual Eparchial Appeal "Share"*, which supports our mission development, including administrative and operational needs of the Eparchy. Going forward we will have three main directions of development in our Eparchy; Missions, Priests's Fund and Seminary Fund.

In addition, the S&D Office leads a seasonal Christmas campaign in support of the *Solidarity Fund*, established by Bishop Benedict. This fund helps address urgent needs within our parishes and provides assistance to clergy throughout the Eparchy.

Since the onset of Russia's full-scale invasion, the Eparchy has raised **\$400,350** to support humanitarian and pastoral efforts in Ukraine. This includes aid for internally displaced persons, medical vehicles and frontline services, and assistance to priests and monasteries serving in war-affected regions of Eastern Ukraine. Thanks to your continued generosity, our chaplains are also able to provide vital pastoral care to soldiers and those in need across the country.

Public Relations and Strategic Partnerships

Building strong relationships is an essential part of advancing the mission of our Eparchy. Through the Stewardship and Development Office, we continue to cultivate meaningful partnerships with Catholic organizations that support our parishes, clergy, and ministries.

We are especially grateful for our collaboration with the *Catholic Extension Society*, whose mission closely aligns with our own. Together, we are working to strengthen underserved parishes, support youth ministry, and expand opportunities for formation including securing partial scholarships for future seminarians.

We also value our partnership with the *United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB)*, whose support has provided important funding for staff development, mission parish assistance, catechetical programs, and ongoing formation for the Eparchial Curia.

These partnerships play a vital role in sustaining and growing the life of our Church, and we are thankful for the opportunities they continue to provide.

Pilgrimage Ministry

Three years ago, the Eparchy established a new opportunity for the faithful seeking a deeper relationship with Christ through the Pilgrimage Center. Pilgrimages offer a profound time of spiritual renewal, inviting participants to step away from daily life and enter more deeply into prayer, reflection, and a personal encounter with God. Through these journeys, our faithful have the opportunity to witness Christ and His teachings in various holy sites, often returning with a strengthened faith, and a greater awareness of God's presence in their lives.

The St. Nicholas Eparchy continues to grow and strengthen this ministry as an important part of its pastoral outreach at home, while the Stewardship and Development Office oversees the organization of international pilgrimages. Last year, a pilgrimage to Lourdes, France, was organized in conjunction with the Mothers in Prayer Meeting; this year, a pilgrimage to Greece is currently underway, while a pilgrimage to Medjugorje is being planned for the fall.

FUNDRAISING HIGHLIGHTS

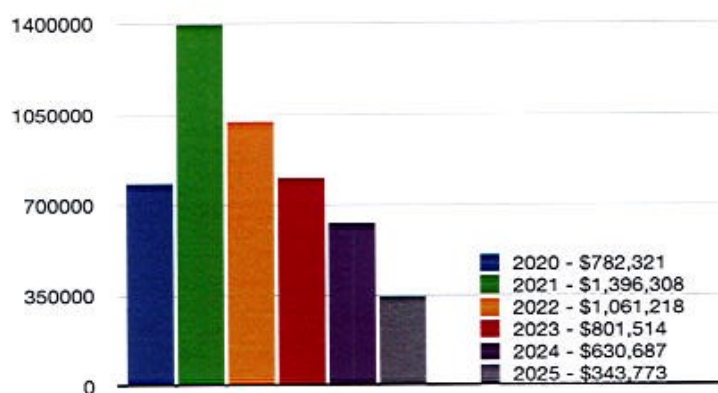
